

PRIVACY POLICY

January 27th, 2022

This Privacy Policy shall apply to all of ITSAL (“**Hereinafter referred to as Company**”) services offered. In the event of any conflict between this Privacy Policy and a separate agreement between you and us, the terms of that separate agreement shall apply to the full extent permitted by the law.
